Title: Request for Expansion of SouthEast Alaska Regional Health Consortium Chiropractic
Medical Services

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 29,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for expanded chiropractic medical services from tribal citizen workers and elderly that would include but not be limited to surgical, pharmaceutical and physical therapy treatment programs and treatment throughout the region; and


WHEREAS, SouthEast Alaska Regional Health Consortium (SEARHC) referrals should be flexible to allow for access to private chiropractic providers available within Southeast Alaska communities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Seventy-Ninth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 9-12, 2014, hereby requests the SouthEast Alaska Regional Health Consortium provide expanded chiropractic medical health services and medical referrals in order to meet the needs of tribal member workers and elderly who reside in Juneau and throughout Southeast Alaska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, such health services should provide for additional personnel, facilities and equipment that would support surgical, pharmaceutical and physical therapy treatment.


