Title: Tribal Certification for Tlingit and Haida Artists Residing Outside of Alaska

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 29,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, not all of our tribal citizens reside in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, all tribal citizens should be able to identify their art as being made by a tribal citizen of a federally recognized tribe; and


WHEREAS, identification of Native artwork such as the Silver hand are only applicable if you reside in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Central Council already maintains a list of tribally-enrolled citizens and could easily issue a locked, printable certificate the size of a business card, that states, "This item was made by a tribally-enrolled citizen of the Central Council of the Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, a federally recognized tribe," and include, name and enrollment number of the tribal citizen.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Seventy-Ninth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 9-12, 2014, hereby supports Tlingit and Haida artists and authorizes Central Council to issue a locked, printable certification to its tribal citizen who are artists so that they may attach to their art work.


