Title: Request to Find Funding for Subsistence Department Development

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 29,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, each tribal citizen has family that participates in subsistence use of our food and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, Central Council is here to represent and do what they can to better our lives; and

WHEREAS, Central Council does not have a subsistence department to fight for our rights to live off the land as our elders have done for years before Alaska became a state.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Seventy-Ninth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 9-12, 2014, hereby requests Central Council to find funding to develop a subsistence department; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all subsistence issues from each community be given to this new department for action; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the new subsistence department be funded every year to help our tribal citizens gain the right to gather our traditional foods without legal interference.


