Resolution EC/ 14-39

Title: Authority to Apply for Family Violence Prevention and Services Grant

WHEREAS, Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 29,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Administration on Children, Youth and Families; Family and Youth Services Bureau, has funding available under the Family Violence Prevention and Services (FVPS); and

WHEREAS, Central Council has partnered with Southeast Alaska Women's Shelters to provide services to women and children who are victims of domestic violence and sexual assault;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes its Tribal Family & Youth Services Department to submit an application to receive funding from the Department of Health and Human Services for fiscal years 2014-2017;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the FVPS Grant for granting funds to Central Council for the proposed women's shelters, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.

ADOPTED this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 2014, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions, and 1 absence(s).
