Resolution EC/ 16-04

Title: Authorization to Apply for funding from U.S. Department of Justice

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 28,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Central Council established a Tribal Court to provide a culturally-appropriate forum for tribal citizens to address their justice needs; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and the Center for Court Innovation announced the availability of funding for fiscal year (FY) 2016 for the implementation of Community Courts; and

WHEREAS, Central Council's Tribal Court wishes to apply for funding to establish a Community Therapeutic Court; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Justice will fund up to \$200,000, including the full amount of Central Council's federally approved indirect rate, for a 24-month project period to begin in 2016 and run through May 31, 2018; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Court to apply for up to \$200,000 in funds from the U.S. Department of Justice to establish a Community Therapeutic Court; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed Community Therapeutic Court, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to said agreement.


