Resolution EC/ 16-10

Title: Authorization to Apply for National Park Service NAGPRA
Consultation/Documentation Grant Funds

WHEREAS, Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) is a federally recognized tribe of more than 30,000 tribal citizens worldwide; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service has announced the availability of FY 2016 grant funds for consultation/documentation visits at museums for federally recognized tribes under Public Law 101-601 of NAGPRA; and

WHEREAS, the Native Lands & Resources Department would like to submit a proposal in the amount of \$88,000.00 for the return of sacred objects and cultural patrimony, and unassociated funerary objects at the Birmingham Museum of Art in Birmingham, Alabama and the Denver Art Museum in Denver, Colorado.

WHEREAS the National Park Service has a cap on indirect costs at 25% and Central Council's approved rate is 29.67% resulting in a short fall in the amount of \$2,535.00

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council hereby authorizes the Central Council President or the Chief Operating Officer to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and contracts that are required from the National Park Service for granting funds to the Central Council for the proposed project, and managing funds on behalf of this entity, including any subsequent amendments to the said agreement.


