

Summer Youth Employment & Training Program (SYETP) Eligibility Requirements and Application Process

SYETP Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be 14-21 years of age;
- Applicants must be an enrolled tribal citizen;
- Applicants must reside in Southeast Alaska; and
- Applicants must meet income guidelines (TANF waiver).

Application Process

- Complete SYETP Application.
- Provide copies of tribal enrollment card, social security card, and identification documenting date of birth.
- Provide proof of Southeast Alaska residency.
- Provide proof of family income for the past 30 days.
- If male and 18-21 years of age, must provide proof of registering with the Selective Service.
- If 14-16 years of age, parent/guardian must complete Section B on Work Permit Form; and complete all hire paperwork:
 - Notice of Hire
 - Employment Eligibility Verification Form
 - W-4
- Must apply by the second week in June.
